Provenance. Thomas Savage's 1876–77 copies (for H.H. Bancroft) of the Spanish- and Mexican-era government records of Alta California, made at the U.S. Surveyor-General's office; the originals burned in the 1906 San Francisco fire, leaving these transcripts the sole record. Manuscripts: Bancroft Library, University of California, Berkeley (BANC MSS C-A 23); digitized microfilm on the Internet Archive (168036074_80_5_2). This calendar is an independent, AI-assisted index with published error rates — verify any record against the manuscript scan before citing (searchable, with scan links: archivesofcalifornia.com). **Coverage:** Tomos I/III (Fages/Borica, 1782–95) item-read docs 1–141 (~no–n290); Tomo IV (Borica, 1794–1800) gap-scanned — the 4 flagged clusters + bonus finds cataloged as docs 142–148 (Fénix closed-door protocol, 1797 anti-English defense, Sal→Administrador Real, Vancouver deserters, Providencia, Moqui expedition, schooling); the Tomo IV routine between clusters bounded.
